

Santa Rosa Junior College Transition to College Timeline

Fall Semester

- Apply to Santa Rosa Junior College**
 - Complete your application online at <https://admissions.santarosa.edu/apply/>. You will need to apply for the semester after your graduation **as a high school graduate**.
 - After you submit your application, you will receive an email with your 9-digit SRJC Student Identification Number (SID). Write that down here: 8 ___ - ___ - ___
 - Once you have your Student ID#, go to our website at <https://drd.santarosa.edu/transition-college> and click on the button to access our Transition to College Canvas information pages.
- Submit Intake forms to Disability Resources Department (DRD)**
 - In order to access services through DRD, you need to submit a Request for Services, Disability Verification documentation (such as a copy of your IEP, 504 plan or a medical verification form signed by a certifying professional) and a Release of Information.
 - Forms can be downloaded at <https://drd.santarosa.edu/Transition-College>
- Attend Information Night**
 - Information Night will be held on both campuses. Students and parents will be able to attend to learn about the steps to Transition to College and how to get set up in Disability Resources once they get to college.
- Complete Intake meeting with specialist**
 - Once you submit your intake packet you will be scheduled for an intake meeting with your specialist to determine appropriate accommodations.
 - You will also discuss your education plan for your first semester.

Spring Semester

- Orientation**
 - New students must complete an Orientation; go to <https://counseling.santarosa.edu/orientation-options> for Orientation options.

April

- Register for Fall and Summer classes**
 - After completing the steps above, you will be eligible for priority registration and can register for your summer and fall classes.

May-August

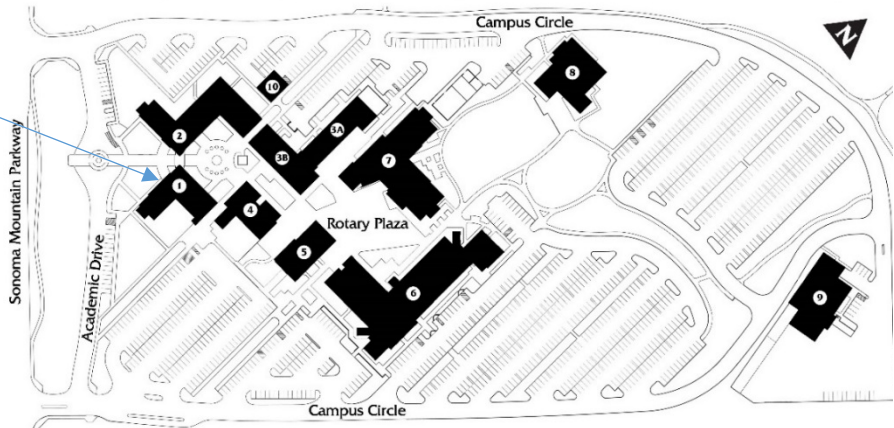
- Attend a follow-up meeting with your specialist (you must complete intake appointment first)**
